## **Texas Civil Justice League PAC Endorses Bailey Moseley** Business Group Lauds Candidate's Experience and Public Service

AUSTIN, TEXAS – The Texas Civil Justice League PAC (TCJL PAC) endorsed Bailey Moseley's bid for the 6th Court of Appeals (Place 2) today.
